# Company History

- 1946 — The founder Seichi Oyaizu began business as an unprocessed green tea broker in Shizuoka Prefecture, Japan.
- 1962 — Began to reprocess unprocessed green teas
- May 1969 — Oyaizu Seicha Co., Ltd. was founded
- October 1975 — A tea processing factory was set up
- April 1979 — Introduced a nitrogen inflation device
- July 1980 — Increased a capital fund to 10 million yen
- June 1981 — Introduced a canning machine
- September 1981 — Introduced a fully automatic tea processing machine
- February 1985 — Introduced a fully automatic packing machine
- April 1987 — Introduced a freezing refrigerator
- August 1990 — Introduced a microwave dryer machine
- August 1991 — Introduced a fully automatic packing machine
- October 1992 — Introduced a state-of-the-art fully automatic tea processing machine
- November 1992 — The head office was founded
- January 1994 — Introduced a GP packing machine and a cartooning machine
- March 1996 — A gift product manufacturing factory was founded
- February 1997 — An analysis center was founded
- November 1998 — Increased the capital fund to 40 million yen

- September 2010 — Obtained ISO9001:2008 certification
- February 2011 — The second Makigaya factory was founded
- March 2011 — Gasho-an café Yaizu store was set up
- November 2011 — Introduced freezers in the first and second Makigaya factories
- April 2013 — Obtained the Mini HACCEP certification for the second Makigaya factory
- April 2014 — Obtained the FSSC22000 certification for the tea processing factory as well as the first and second Makigaya factories
- April 2016 — A workshop was set up in the Tegoshi area of Shizuoka
